What Is **Squint** (Strabismus)?

Squint, also known as **strabismus**, is a condition in which the eyes are not properly aligned and point in different directions.

One eye may look straight while the other may turn:

- 👁 Inward (Esotropia)
- 👁 Outward (Exotropia)
- 👁 Upward (Hypertropia)
- 👁 Downward (Hypotropia)

Common Causes of Squint

- Congenital (Present Since Birth)
- Refractive Errors (Need for Glasses)
- Weak Eye Muscles
- Neurological Conditions
- Eye Injury or Trauma
- Poor Vision in One Eye

Signs & Symptoms

- Eyes Not Looking in the Same Direction
- Closing One Eye in Bright Light
- Head Tilting Frequently
- Double Vision
- Poor Depth Perception
- Eye Strain or Fatigue
- Cosmetic Concern About Eye Appearance

⚠ Untreated squint in children may lead to Amblyopia (Lazy Eye) and reduced visual development.



Squint Evaluation Process

- 01 Comprehensive Eye Examination
- 02 Vision Assessment
- 03 Eye Alignment & Muscle Testing
- 04 Treatment Planning

Treatment Options

✓ Spectacles

Some squints improve with proper glasses.

✓ Lazy Eye (Amblyopia) Treatment

Patching therapy or vision rehabilitation may be recommended.

✓ Vision Therapy

Selected patients may benefit from eye exercises.

✓ Squint Surgery

Surgery adjusts the eye muscles to improve alignment and appearance.
